

## WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT of 2000 (WRDA 2000)

### Historical information

- March 22, 2000 - Dr. Joseph W. Westphal, the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Civil Works) provided [testimony](#) on WRDA 2000 before the House Water Resources and Environment Subcommittee, Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
- April 10, 2000 - Dr. Westphal transmitted to the President of the Senate and the [Speaker of the House](#) the Army WRDA 2000 proposal - [Bill](#) and [Report](#) language.
- April 13, 2000 - [S. 2437](#) (Administration's WRDA 2000) was introduced by Senator Smith (R-NH), by request.
- May 9, 2000 - [H.R. 4411](#) (Administration's WRDA 2000) was introduced by Representative Shuster (R-PA), by request
- May 23, 2000 - The Transportation and Infrastructure Subcommittee of the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee received testimony on the Administration's WRDA 2000 from the Department of the Army, the Corps of Engineers and non-Federal interests. - July 27, 2000 - The Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works ordered to be reported, with an amendment in the nature of a substitute, [S. 2796](#). The accompanying Committee Report is [SRept. 106-362](#).
- September 25, 2000 - The Senate amended and passed [S. 2796](#)
- October 19, 2000 - The House amended in the nature of a substitute and passed [S. 2796](#), then sent the House amendment to the Senate and requested a conference.
- October 31, 2000 - The Senate agreed to Conference Report [\(HRept 106-1020\)](#) by unanimous consent. The House approved the Report on November 3, 2000.
- November 3, 2000 - [S. 2796](#) was cleared for enrollment. A Headquarters Civil Works Directorate [slide presentation](#) highlights the impacts of WRDA 2000, as enrolled.
